

Invitation for Contributions Africanisation-Decolonisation Indaba 2024

An event hosted by the Africanisation-Decolonisation Working Group (ADWG) and the Transdisciplinary Institute for Mandela Studies (TIMS) in collaboration with the University Faculties as part of the University's Africanisation-Decolonisation Project (AfDeP)

Initially planned for October 2023, the Africanisation-Decolonisation Indaba has been postponed to 7 and 8 March 2024. The organising team extends their sincerest apologies for any inconvenience caused and would like, once again, to extend an open invitation to the Mandela University community to share their contributions to Africanisation and decolonisation.

The Indaba will take the form of a university 'get-together' where different modes are encouraged as a basis for sharing, learning, contestation and communal growth.
